About the instructor:



Mr. William Healy retired from the law enforcement community with over 29 years of experience.

For 25 years he had been a member of the Ohio State Highway Patrol and was the Commander of the Highway Patrol's Traffic Drug Interdiction Team (TDIT), a program out of Columbus, Ohio. Mr. Healy has a Bachelor's Degree from Ohio University and a Master's Degree from Central Michigan University in General Administration. He is a graduate of the Southern Police Institute's Administrative Officer's Course at the University of Louisville, and has served as an instructor at the Northwestern University Traffic Institute (NUTI), the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP), the Ohio Attorney General's Conference on Law Enforcement, the Drug Enforcement Administration, and the Drug Interdiction Assistance Program. In addition, Mr. Healy is a former adjunct professor of constitutional law at Ohio University. He has also served as an expert on search and seizure while serving on various search and seizure instructional panels at the Ohio Attorney General's Conference on Law Enforcement. He has instructed constitutional case law on a variety of constitutional issues, including civil liability, laws of arrest and search & seizure within the law enforcement community for the past 30 years. He has been a certified instructor with the Ohio Peace Officer's Training Academy (OPOTA) for over 31 years.
