*This 4 hour course will focus on:*

“Search and Seizure” is designed to provide information to attorneys and law enforcement officers concerning search and seizure with emphasis upon conducting warrantless searches. The seven exceptions to the warrant rule will be discussed in detail to include: stop and frisk, search incident to arrest, probable cause, plain view, plain feel, inventory and consent. Constitutional case law decisions from both the U.S. Supreme Court and the Ohio Supreme Court will be discussed.

## ABOUT THE INSTRUCTOR:



**William D. Healy** was a career law enforcement officer who had been a member of the law enforcement community for the past 29 years. For the past 24 years, Mr. Healy had been a member of the Ohio State Highway Patrol and was the coordinator of the Highway Patrol's Traffic Drug Interdiction Team (TDIT). Mr. Healy has a Bachelor's degree from Ohio University and a Master's degree from Central Michigan University, **Mr. Healy** is a graduate of the Southern Police Institute's Administrative Officers Course at the University of Louisville. He has served as an instructor for the Northwestern University Traffic Institute (NUTI), the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP), the Drug Enforcement Administration, and the Drug Interdiction Assistance Program. Mr. Healy is a former adjunct professor of constitutional law at Ohio University. He has also served as an expert on search and seizure while serving on various search and seizure instructional panels at the Ohio Attorney General's Conference on Law Enforcement for over five years.
