CPT TRAINING INFORMATION:

In 2022, the AG and OPOTA announced that 24 hours of Continuing Professional Training (CPT) will be required for all law enforcement officers. Sworn officers and troopers who graduated from an academy in 2021 or earlier will be required to take 24 hours of advanced training in 2022. All of the training being provided at the Whitehall Police Department has been approved by OPOTA for 8 hours of CPT training.

Legal Updates (4 hours)

Constitutional 4th Amendment case law decisions from the U.S. and Ohio Supreme Courts will be discussed and new Ohio laws enacted by the State Legislature in 2021 will be reviewed. In addition, a thorough review of Search and Seizure will be conducted with emphasis on why cops stop people, the length of investigative detentions and the 7 exceptions to the search warrant requirement; stop & frisk, search incident to arrest, motor vehicle probable cause, plain view, plain feel, inventory and consent searches.

Use of Force (4 hours)

All use of force issues and claims are 4th Amendment seizures and constitutional case law decisions from the U.S. and Ohio Supreme Courts will be reviewed. In addition, the standards on when, how and how much force can be used will be discussed. Liability issues related to use of force will be thoroughly reviewed.

INSTRUCTOR: WILLIAM D. HEALY was a career law enforcement officer for over 29 years. For 24 years Mr. Healy had been a member of the Ohio State Highway Patrol and was the Commander of the Highway Patrol's Traffic Drug Interdiction Team (TDIT). He also served for over five years as a manager/instructor at the Highway Patrol Academy. Mr. Healy has Bachelor's Degree from Ohio University and a Master's Degree from Central Michigan University in Administration. He is a graduate of Southern Police Institute's Administrative Officer's Course at the University of Louisville. He has trained tens of thousands of officers in a variety of disciplines for the past 35 years. He is currently the Director of the North Coast Polytechnic Institute.
